ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWALS

- 1. Admission is made on written application in the prescribed form duly filled in and signed .The form can be obtained from the school office on payment of Rs. 100/- each .Registration of names is no guarantee for admission.
- 2. Age of admission shall be regulated as follows. The student should complete '5' Years on 31st of May of the school year in which admission is sought for class 1. For other classes age of admission shall be regulated accordingly.
- 3. The management reserves the right to admit any applicant only by producing T.C/Birth Certificate, Aadhaar copy.
- 4. School fee (Yearly/Termly/Monthly) should be paid in advance at the time of admission. School fees for the complete year shall be paid irrespective of the number of days one has attended. All dues should be cleared before the examination. Students who withdraw on any grounds will have to pay full fees for the whole year .Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 5. All students who seek admission will have to satisfy our entrance requirements and they should pay the preliminary fees when they are admitted.

RULES OF THE SCHOOL

II.DECORUM

The school uniform is compulsory on all working days and at all school functions. Pupils are expected to come to school neat and tidy. Boys should have their hair well trimmed and combed. Girls should have their hair well plaited and set with red ribbon. No flower or decorative ornaments should adorn the hair. On wednesdays all students should wear house jersey anf girls use their house colour ribbon.

III. FEES

- (a) Fees to be paid on or before 10th of every month preferably by Net Banking and produce proof to school.
- (b) A flat penalty of ₹ 50/- to be paid for late payment between 11-17th of each month.
- (c) A penalty of ₹15/- per day to be paid for late payment between 18th 25th of each month.
- (d) After 25th of each month, the fee defaulters would be prohibited from attending the classes.

AVAILING OF BUS SERVICES

- 1. The parents who wish to utilize the bus services should inform the office preferably by writing at the beginning of the academic year itself.
- 2. Change of route shall not be applicable for the academic year. In an extreme case, the route change may be allowed in the following conditions:
- a. The change of route or bus should be informed in the office in person by giving at least 3 copies of letter for the same.
- b. The parent should confirm the approval of route change and should be present on the first day while boarding the bus.
- 3. Casual change of route is not approved.
- 4. Parent should permit school to take at least one week time to normalize the change of route and to acquaint with the new bus and other children.
- 5. As per new rules, all buses are fitted with GPS and all are to utilize the tracking system. A nominal fee will be charged at the beginning of school academic year.
- 6. All parents are to note that by using the school buses we, both parents and school staff, can have better attention on the children, especially on the higher class children. Therefore parents are advised to utilise school buses.

- 1. At the first bell, students should keep silence and spend time for assembly preparation. For the next bell, the students have to proceed to the assembly ground accompanied by their class teachers on assembly days. Students have to maintain proper order and silence when they go in and out of the class.
- 2. Books and periodicals, pictures, video games, comics, cutting instruments, toys, etc which are not approved by the school authorities will be confiscated.
- 3. Disobedience to the teachers ,speaking ill of others, irregular attendance, habitual inattention in the class , indecent words or action, damaging school property or any other behaviour which are considered as detrimental to the good tone of the school by the authority of the school are sufficient reasons for disciplinary action.

- 4. Students of one class are not allowed to enter other classroom without permission even during intervals.Running, playing, whistling or shouting inside the school building are not allowed.
- 5. Students are not allowed to enter the staff room without permission.
- 6. The school authority reserves the right to dismiss students whose diligence or progress is constantly unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other students.
- 7. Students should not bring any electronic gadgets to school. The school is not responsible for any loss. *Use of mobile phone by the student is not allowed in the school campus.*
- 8. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, neglect of home work, disobedience or disrespect towards members of the staff and others, forging signature, stealing or bad moral influence etc justifies dismissal of the student .Pupils are responsible to the school authorities for their conduct both in and outside the school. Even the parents are expected to show due respect and regard to the teachers.
- 9. Students found using malpractices(copying etc.)will not get any marks for that subjects and will also be dismissed/ suspended/ may be asked to leave the school.

- I. There are monthly 4 Examinations held in the year as per the remodelled assessment of CBSE.


SUGGESTION BOX:
